

Make sure to check weather conditions and tide times before your departure.

South-west side of Havre Aubert Island

⚠ When winds north-easterly.

Cross seas and breaking waves. Seas may become very confused.

La Passe

⚠ When winds southerly and south-easterly.

Breaking seas, especially at ebb tide.

Shoals between the dune at Sandy Hook and Entry Island

(breaking waves).

Navigation

L'ANSE À LA CABANE

De l'Ouest (West) Beach (HA1) – Anse du Bassin (HA4)

Level : Moderate – Demanding 13,6 km

The cliffs along the south shore of Havre Aubert Island are breathtakingly beautiful. Le Gros Cap (« Cap de la Roche ») shelters many different bird species and bird watchers will be delighted with what they find there. Circuit relatively sheltered from north winds.

LES DEMOISELLES

Beach -Plage du Cap (HA7) – Les Plaisanciers du Havre Marina (HA6)

Level : Easy 7,2 km

Les Demoiselles, one of the geomorphological and geological jewels of the archipelago, are steeply-sloped, rounded hills composed of red, green and gray clay, basalt, gypsum and alabaster. Seen from the water, they are a spectacular sight. Use the La Grave historical site as your starting or arrival point, and you will also be able to stroll along and enjoy the relaxed, convivial atmosphere of the site. Circuit relatively well protected from south-west winds.
