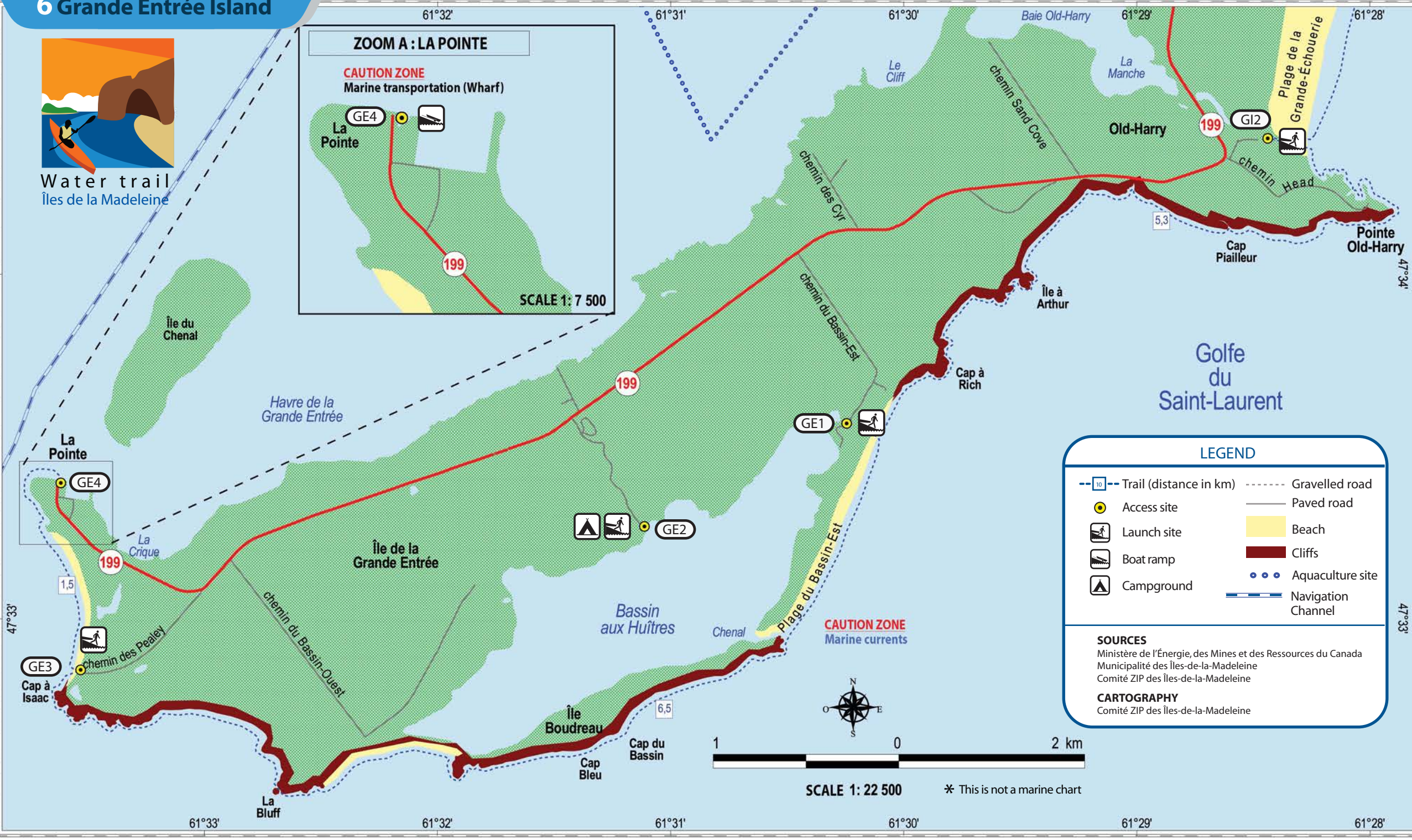
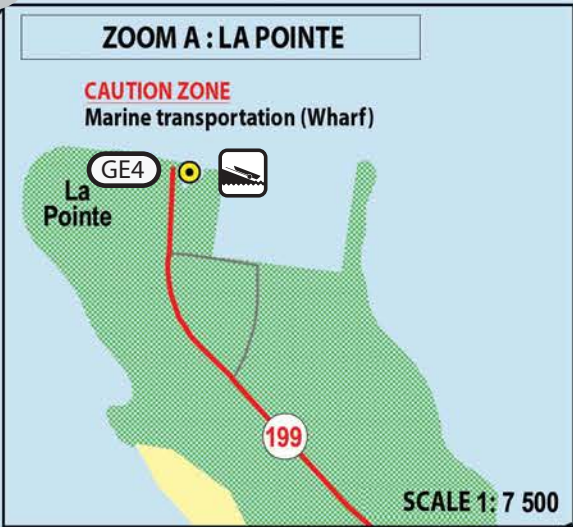

### TOUR OF GRANDE-ENTRÉE

Beach at la Grande Échouerie (GI2) – Port of Grande-Entrée (GE4)

Level : Moderate 13,1 km

Get a close look at the natural caves in the cliffs near Old Harry and paddle along the shore of Île Boudreau (picture opposite) in the lovely Bassin aux Huîtres until you come to the archipelago's largest commercial fishing port.
