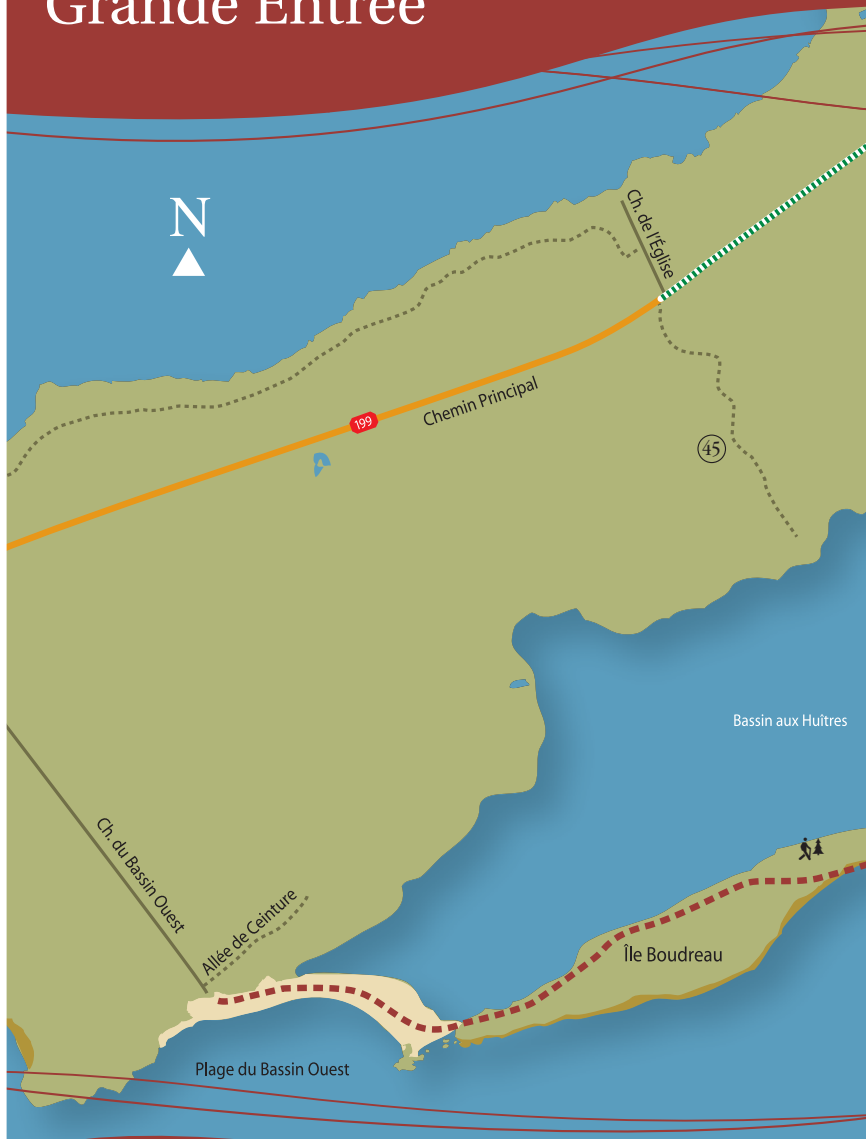


## 8 Boudreau Island Grande Entrée



**Suggested departure /arrival:** Chemin du Bassin Ouest

**Distance:** 2 km

**Type of trail :** Linear

**Number of trails :** 1

**Level :** Intermediate

**Description :** L'Île Boudreau, with a surface area of about 23 hectares, is located on the southern part of Grande Entrée Island. In fact, it is a peninsula rather than an island, since it can be reached anytime along Chemin du Bassin Ouest and the Plage de la Bluff (2 km). It can also be accessed at low tide along the beach at Bassin Est (3 km). The Magdalen Islands Conservation Society (SCÎM) acquired the property in 2004 to protect it from any development that might be potentially incompatible with its conservation. The SCÎM is grateful to you for respecting the Madelinot heritage and following these simple rules :

**Permitted Activities :**

Pedestrian access only;

Occasional non-commercial berry picking, by hand.

**Forbidden Activities :**

Motor vehicles are not permitted beyond the road and parking area;

Camping, camp trailers and campfires;

Littering, dropping garbage of any kind;

Intensive or mechanized berry picking and collecting alabaster;

Any activities that might damage or cause eventual damage to the property's ecological integrity.
