Our new concept allows us to offer guests a unique season every year, adapting our programs to the reality of climate change so that guests will have a chance to enjoy the most magnificent winter experience ever: seal pups watching on the Magdalen Islands!

CONCEPT

From Feburary 22th to March 10th, 2020, you'll be able to take a special helicopter flight to enjoy the one-of-a-kind winter experience of watching baby seals on the pack ice between February 21 and March 18, 2019, on the Magdalen Islands.

Climate change in recent years has forced us to reconsider how to continue offering guests our winter experience, which has made Château Madelinot's reputation throughout the world for 35 years. Our objective remains unchanged: to provide our guests an exceptional experience against the backdrop of the unique Magdalen Islands archipelago.

Come enjoy this special experience from up in the sky; see the harp seals on the pack ice in the Gulf of St. Lawrence; watch the mothers taking care of their young; take photos of the little faces of the white seal pups against the snow and ice that stretch as far as the eye can see. The Magdalen Islands are the only place in the world where you can see harp seal pups.

And if the ice is thick enough, our helicopters will land only metres away from a spectacular herd of whitecoats (harp seals). Accompanied by our guide, you'll have the privilege of observing them up close, in their natural habitat.

In addition to the seal-watching experience, you'll be able to admire the immensity of the natural surroundings and enjoy a host of unique activities and landscapes.

How many days are recommended for this visit?

Because of changing weather conditions, and to take full advantage of your time on the Islands and maximize your chances of touching down on the ice, we recommend a stay of <u>at least</u> three nights.

WEATHER & CLOTHING

On average, the weather on the **Magdalen Islands** in February and March ranges from **-10 to -20 degrees.**

Equipment provided in the package:

For the helicopter outings, guests will be provided with a **Mustang flotation suit**, which is warm enough for going out on the pack ice. We recommend wearing a polar fleece suit or long underwear underneath it. Boots are also available.

*Note that it is mandatory to wear a Mustang flotation suit on helicopter outings.

Winter hats and mittens are available for purchase at the hotel shop. Snowshoes, poles and all other equipment needed for the activities will be provided.

What you should bring:

We recommend that you bring the following items with you in order to get the most out of the outdoor activities:

- Winter jacket and pants
- Polar fleece suit or long underwear
- Winter hat and gloves (bring gloves that will allow you to handle your camera equipment)

ACTIVITIES

DESCRIPTION OF PACKAGE ACTIVITIES

Every day, a schedule is posted offering 6 activities to all package guests, including the not-to-be-missed helicopter outing. Among the options are: an outdoor activity, a discovery/photo activity or a discovery/culture activity.

N.B.: The schedule is subject to change at any time by hotel management depending on the weather conditions prevailing during your stay. We want to treat our guests to activities that are enjoyable and totally safe. If we are forced to cancel an activity, our management team will see to it that an alternative activity is provided. Your cooperation and understanding will be greatly appreciated.

ACTIVITY: HELICOPTER

Total duration of the outing: 3 hours (may vary, depending on conditions)

Maximum number of passengers per helicopter: 6 Landing on the pack ice: conditions permitting

When ice conditions allow, our helicopters will touch down within viewing distance of a stunning herd of whitecoats (harp seals). Accompanied by our guide, you'll have the privilege of seeing them up close in their natural habitat. You'll be awed not only by the seal-watching experience, but also by the vastness of the landscape surrounding you. The magnificent views from the helicopter will also satisfy your appetite for discovery and excitement. Several routes are available depending on prevailing flight conditions, but the goal is always the same: to provide breathtaking views of plants and wildlife.

Notes:

The safety of our operations is our top priority. A decision about landing on the pack ice will be made by 9:00 a.m. of the scheduled day based on the pack ice conditions in the Gulf of St. Lawrence.

Is it possible to reserve more than one helicopter outing?

When weather conditions and availability allow, we offer guests the possibility of reserving additional three (3)- or six (6)-hour helicopter outings.

The cost of an additional flight can vary depending on the flight itinerary (whether it lands on the pack ice or not) and can range from *\$800* to *\$1,200* per person per flight. Guests who are interested in taking additional flights will be informed about pricing only when they are at the hotel.

Note that only the flight included in the package is guaranteed (depending on conditions) before the guest's arrival. We cannot guarantee additional flights.

ACTIVITIES: CULTURE AND DISCOVERY

Guided tours of the Islands ->

Duration: 3 hours/tour

Aboard a comfortable, 18-seat private shuttle, find out more about the archipelago from an enthusiastic

local guide.

EASTERN part of the archipelago

The high points of the tour of the EASTERN part: fishing ports, a view of the salt mine, a visit to the Seal Interpretation Centre, Old Harry Beach (on National Geographic's list of the world's top 10 beaches), the village of Grande-Entrée and lots more!

② CENTRAL part of the archipelago

The high points of the tour of the CENTRAL part are: the village of Havre-aux-Maisons (cheese dairy, lighthouse, smokehouse, etc.), the village of Fatima (Mi-carême Museum), the village of Étang-du-Nord (fishing port, statue of fishermen) and lots more!

WESTERN part of the archipelago

The highlights of the tour of the WESTERN part are: the village of Havre-Aubert, La Grave historical site, *Musée de la mer* (museum of the sea), *Économusée des Artisans du sable* (sand art museum), scenic route and much more!

Introduction to Fishing Workshop

Duration: 2 hours

Under the guidance of Christian Vigneau, a friendly local fisherman who owns *CULTURES DU LARGE*, you'll have the privilege of entering the world of oyster farming and lobster fishing. Be one of the fortunate people to learn the secrets of this islander. Tasting included.

Mid-Lent storytelling and cultural exchange workshop (new)

Duration: 2 hours

The Magdalen Islands are unique, whether in their colours, flavours or their love of partying! Mid-Lent is the proof. This carnival, which dates back to medieval times in Europe, is still celebrated in Canada, but only in 6 localities in Quebec and Acadia, one of which is Fatima, at our hotel, the Château Madelinot. Want to get to know the archipelago and the islanders as few visitors do? This is your chance! Come discover this tradition deeply rooted in the heart of the Magdalen Islands by sharing it with ACTUAL REVELLERS! You'll be sure to enjoy a foot-tapping reel or two.

Duration: 90 minutes

Guided outing for a sunrise photo safari.

Guided outing for a sunset photo safari.

Outing to Bout du banc

Duration: 4 hours

Guided outing by motor vehicle (external transportation) to *Bout du banc*. Be one of the lucky few who get a chance to walk to the end of Sandy Hook Beach, which offers a spectacular view of *Ile d'Entrée*. And if you're really lucky, you might even see seals on shore.

Ice fishing

Duration: 3 hours

Guided outing for an ice fishing activity with a local fisherman. Fish for Gulf of St. Lawrence mackerel, a unique and unforgettable experience.

Evening under the stars

Guided outing to *Butte du vent* – a yurt and campfire await you.
